Both husband and wife must understand the five principles upon which every successful marriage is built.
1. A (Ephesians 2:8-9). Both husband and wife genuinely know the Lord Jesus as personal Savior. Both give testimony to the Lord's saving work in their lives.
2. A (Song of Solomon 5:16). It is not sufficient to sa "We're both in love!" For a marriage to be successful, there must be a growing relationship where both husband and wife are becoming best friends.

3. A (Ephesians 5:21). While there are plenty of disappointments along the way, both the husband and wife must have a sense of respecting their mate. This comes from sharing common core values which both embrace and hold.
4. A (Philippians 3:10). Both husband and wife must share the passion for knowing the Lord and growing in His knowledge and ways.
5. A (Amos 3:3). This means that we genuinely are sharing common convictions, held beliefs, and agree on the things that matter most in life.
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
